Board exams: Pearson initiative to prepare students for stress free exams

Our Method to ease the preparation:

- We have well prepared Vertically connected topics right from grade VI (connected to X)
- We design special work sheets, question papers and remedial plan to reinforce the concept which is related to grade X (from grade 6 onwards)
- Year plan to complete concepts of grade 9 by December to focus on linked topics of grades 9 and 10 for easy transition for the students.
- Year plan to complete concepts of grade 10 by October, so that the revision schedule followed by remedial plan started from the month of November.
- Three session plans (revision plan) for each month November, December and January to complete the revision of whole syllabus.
- Three pre-boards in complete syllabus in the months of December, January and February.
- Math and Science Subject Matter Experts are appointed to provide in-depth knowledge of concepts after school hours and guide students in board preparation as well as for competitive exams. For other subjects after school schedule to practice enrichment worksheets and for remediation.
- Adoption plan to encourage and inspire students to believe in themselves.

Home support:

- We help our students to organize their time table at home (before and after school hours).
- Parents need to display this time table to keep a check on their regular routine and ensure to interact with them to motivate for the exam without taking any stress.
